



The <u>Charity</u> nominees for the 2014-15 WOW year will be presented at the September luncheon. The charities presenting information on the goals of their charity will be:

FREE- a Christian ministry supported by individual gifts and private foundations. FREE is dedicated to providing the relationships and practical lifelines necessary to empower incarcerated men and women who are leaving jail and prison to remain free. It is their guiding principle that lives are truly transformed only in relationships. The goal is to assist in the transition from prison to society and building self-sustaining lives.

<u>HARBOR HOUSE</u> - Harbor House seeks to eliminate domestic violence by providing safety, shelter, counseling, education, advocacy and justice. Harbor House has been highly regarded as one of the best comprehensive domestic violence programs in the State of Florida. There are five main programs to support in their mission: emergency shelter, children's services, community outreach, legal advocacy services and community & professional education. The main program is the 110 bed emergency shelter that is operated 24 hours a day for women and child survivors of family violence. This life saving program has been in operation for 34 years and is the only State certified domestic violence shelter in Orange County.

<u>MATTHEW'S HOPE -</u> Matthew's Hope fosters the physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being of the homeless men, women, and children of our West Orange community by meeting basic needs, developing skills, and restoring dignity and independence. There are no "hand-outs" everyone works for the assistance received.
