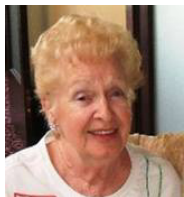

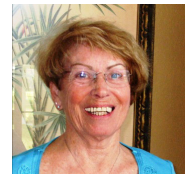

WEST ORANGE WOMEN BY-LAWS CHANGE

Mary Borgan has done a fantastic job the past two (2) years as our Membership Vice-President. No one has stepped up to take this position, and Mary is willing to continue, so we will be voting at the **MARCH 16, 2017** general (luncheon) meeting to temporarily change the WOW BY-LAWS to allow her to continue to serve.

Our current by-laws in Article V – Section 2 states:

Term: Officers shall serve for a minimum term of one (1) year. No officer may succeed herself in the same office for more than two (2) consecutive terms, except Treasurer who may serve for four (4) years, if needed. Newly elected officers shall assume office following the May Installation ceremony.

A vote will be conducted at the March 16, 2017 general meeting (luncheon) to make the following change:

Term: Officers shall serve for a minimum term of one (1) year. No officer may succeed herself in the same office for more than two (2) consecutive terms, except Treasurer who may serve for four (4) years, if needed. **A temporary revision for the Second Vice-President, Mary Borgan, who may serve for an additional four (4) years, beginning 6-1-17 and ending no later than 5-31-21. This temporary revision will be removed from the by-laws 5-31-21 or earlier if Mary Borgan leaves the position.** Newly elected officers shall assume office following the May installation ceremony.

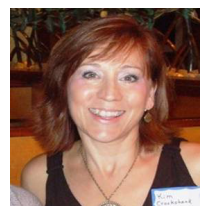
